INFO Whinyard Rocks is a small-scale low-intervention vineyard of 4000 vines across 3 acres

TASTING NOTE

Still red wine, deep red in colour. Light to medium bodied. A cherry-tinged gambol of crushed wind-swept blackcurrants, delicate peppered spice and a frolicking tickle of vanilla. A completely natural red wine made with no additions, just grapes.

SERVE

Drink now to two years.

WINEMAKING

Regent and Rondo grapes were crushed and destemmed and naturally fermented with skins for 7 days then gently pressed with press wine added back into the blend. Aged in 70% light toast oak, 30% steel. Vintages racked and blended. Bottled by gravity.

No filtration

No fining
